 friendship between Gonzalès and Manet endured following her death. While little of her own correspondence survives, his letters to her after Manet painted Gonzalès, Paris was besieged during the Franco-Prussian War. Gonzalès left for Dieppe in November 1870, Manet wrote to her from Paris: "a mutual lady friend who is also here under the siege is inflicting on us, that of not seeing you is certainly the hardest to bear... Degas and I are in the artillery, as volunteers. I'm looking forward to having you paint my portrait in my huge room's greatcoat when you're back."
 was witness at her marriage to Henri Oudéard, and Manet sketched her in a letter written to Gonzalès in 1880. In another letter in July of 1881, following the exhibition of a pastel at the Salon, Manet wrote: "I have been singing your praises every day, and since you have finally asked my advice, I should like to share in the rejoicing"

 This painting of cut flowers relates closely to the flower lying on the floor in Manet's portrait of Eva Gonzalès painted a direct response to Manet's painting, Storm of Pink Peonies and a Beetle (c.1871 – 2), in which she changed the colour of the blooms and replaced the secateurs with a May beetle or cockchafer. At the time, the name of the insect was used to refer to an exuberant character, perhaps a comment on Manet himself.

Christ Church Cathedral

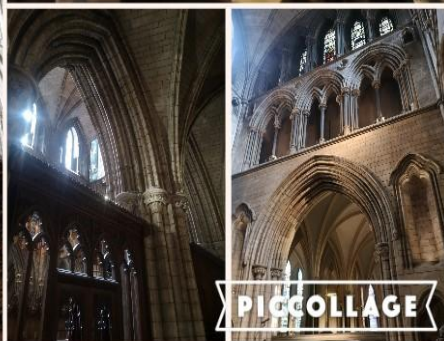
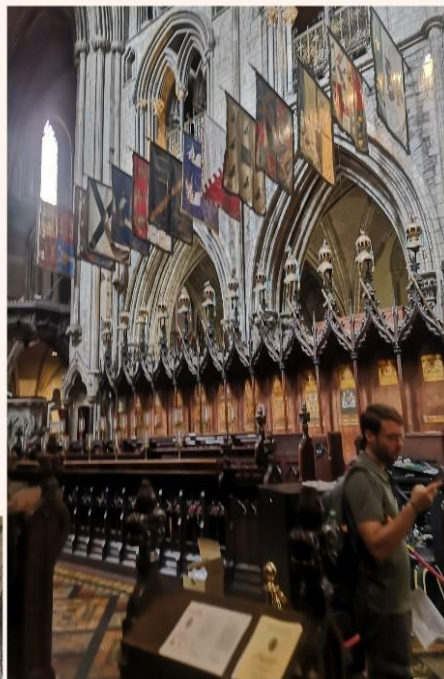
È la cattedrale, in stile gotico, della diocesi anglicana di Dublino e Glendalough. Costruita per volontà del primo re vichingo, nel 1038, dopo la sua conversione al cristianesimo. Distrutta da un incendio, fu ricostruita dai Normanni fra gli anni 1173 e 1240. L'attuale struttura risale al 1870.



ST. PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL

La cattedrale di San Patrizio è la più grande delle due cattedrali protestanti, in stile gotico, di Dublino.

Il suo organo è uno dei più grandi di tutta l'Irlanda, con oltre 4000 canne.





TRINITY COLLEGE



Il Trinity College di Dublino è un istituto d'istruzione, tra i più antichi d'Irlanda. Nasce ufficialmente nel 1592 ad opera di Elisabetta I. La biblioteca al suo interno comprende circa duecentomila testi ed un'importante collezione di antichi manoscritti, fra cui il famoso Libro di Kells. Tra gli ex studenti del Trinity College ci sono Samuel Beckett, Oscar Wilde, Edmund Burke e Oliver Goldsmith; le statue degli ultimi due si trovano all'esterno dell'ingresso.

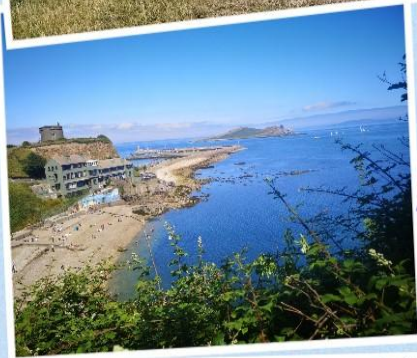

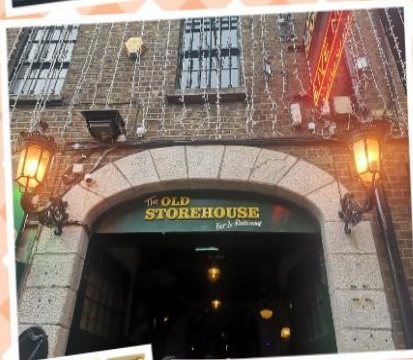
