


### PODCAST

"Podcast" is a portmanteau, a combination of "iPod" and "broadcast".

The term "podcasting" was first suggested by The Guardian columnist and BBC journalist Ben Hammersley, who invented it in early February 2004 while writing an article for The Guardian.

#### The Driving Question

A driving question is presented as the frame for the project.

A good driving question is one that "focuses all other questions towards a solution or product"

It is **open-ended** 

It engages high-level thinking

It requires students to synthesize information from multiple sources, experiences, and activities




### Music Thinking Strategies







